## Terms and Conditions

Membership of the ROA does not automatically mean you are accepted onto the Racecourse Badge Scheme for Owners ("RBSO"). You must meet the following qualifying criteria for your card to be activated:

- You must be a fully registered owner with Weatherbys.
- You must own at least 50% of a horse registered in full training, or the equivalent in part ownerships.

A horse is regarded as being in full training when this is reflected in the "horses in training return" submitted to Weatherbys by the trainer.

- You must hold a current Horseracing Privilege Photocard.

If you do not have one, please attach a passport sized photograph in the space overleaf. A Photocard will then be sent to you.

Acceptance onto the RBSO provides one complimentary members' badge at participating fixtures to the Horserace Privilege Photocard holder only. This is strictly non-transferable. Abuse of this could result in the members' place on the scheme being revoked.

Owners with runners on the day will only receive their standard allocation of badges. The RBSO cannot be used to add to this quota.

Only owners with runners on the day will have access to the Owners' and Trainers' facilities.

Members who let their ROA subscription lapse will lose their RBSO place. This can be reinstated on reactivation of membership.

The scheme runs from January 1<sup>st</sup> 2010 to December 31<sup>st</sup> 2010.

Applications must be made annually. Application forms are sent to all members in the autumn, and to new members when they join.

### What happens next?

Your application will be processed as soon as possible. We are unable to acknowledge receipt of application forms.

Qualifying members will receive a letter of confirmation and booklet of participating fixtures directly from Weatherbys. Your card will not be activated for the scheme until you receive the fixtures booklet.

**YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE A NEW HORSERACING PRIVILEGE PHOTOCARD. IF YOU ALREADY HOLD A PHOTOCARD IT WILL BE ACTIVATED FOR THE SCHEME.**

Activation of the card will expire on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2010.

Members who are applying for next year's scheme will receive notification in December 2009 if their application has been accepted.

Members who do not initially qualify are held on file and checked on a weekly basis for when their horses come back into training. Once they do qualify, the fixtures booklet will be sent to them as confirmation they have been accepted the scheme. Their place on the scheme will still expire on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2010.

The scheme is limited to 4,000 places, and is run on a "first come first served" basis.
